Corp. Reuben Luedtke Dies in New Guinea

Marshfield, Wis.—Another Marshfield soldier, Corp. Reuben V. Luedtke, 24, died in action in New Guinea, a telegram to his father from the war department this morning revealed.
Corporal Luedtke's death occurred December 11, according to the telegram which came to his father, Max, of Klondike. The death brought to six the number of local men killed in the New Guinea fighting.
The father last heard from his son in a letter written November 25. Reuben was born in the town of Richfield and attended Marshfield schools. A brother, Verle, is in the navy and a sister, Mrs. Lorine Barker, lives in Chicago. The mother is dead.
