

Services Set For Madison On Thursday

WAUSAU — Military rites will be conducted at the West Side Helke Funeral Home here at 1:30 p. m. Thursday for Airman David Madison, 21, son of Mr. and Mrs. M. C. Madison, former Marshfield residents.

Airman Madison, who had been stationed at Luke Air Base, Phoenix, Ariz., was fatally injured in a surfing accident near Los Angeles, Calif., on Sept. 3, and died in a hospital there on Sept. 7.

Mr. and Mrs. Madison flew to Los Angeles when notified of the accident and were there when he died. The body is being flown back to Wisconsin, accompanied by a military escort.

David Madison was born on Sept. 16 and attended grade school at Marshfield and Wausau, graduated from Wausau Senior High School in 1964 and had attended Marathon County Technical School and Stout State University at Menomonie.

He entered the Air Force in July, 1966, received basic training at Lackland AFB, San Antonio, Texas, and was stationed at Lowry AFB, Denver, before going to Phoenix.

As a member of the Wausau Chapter of DeMolay he had received the second highest honor of the order, that of Chevalier. He is survived by his parents, a sister, Mrs. Judy Grabeau, and by his maternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Fred Peterson of Amherst.
