Belgrade radio said it was feared the wreckage concealed many more dead.

Officials in Debar reported; after telephone communication was re-established, that almost every house in town was de-stroyed or so badly damaged as to be uninhabitable. Seven thousand of the town's 8,000 res

In Uppsala, Sweden, the sels-mological institution said the quake registered 6.5- on the Richter scale, half a point stronger than the 1983 earth-quake which destroyed Skopje, the capital of Yugoslav Macedonia donia.

The seismological institute at Skopje said the quake today-was-centered 65 miles to the west, an area just over the Albanian border. No damage was reported in Skopje, which was rebuiltafter the 1963 quake.
