## Love Company 35th Infantry Regiment Korean War

"Not For Fame or Reward Not For Place or For Rank But In Simple Obedience To Duty as They Understood It"





The 35th Infantry Regiment Association salutes our fallen brother, CPL Vernon Leon Kesler, ER16230554, who died in the service of his country on January 26th, 1951 in South Korea. The cause of death was listed as KIA. At the time of his death Vernon was 22 years of age. He was from Marshfield, Wisconsin. Vernon's Military Occupation Specialty was 4745-Light Weapons Infantryman.

The decorations earned by CPL Vernon Leon Kesler include: the Combat Infantryman Badge, the Purple Heart, the National Defense Service Medal, the Korean Service Medal, the United Nations Korea Service Medal, and the Republic of Korea War Service Medal.

Corporal Kesler was a member of the 35th Infantry Regiment, 25th Infantry Division. He was Killed in Action while fighting the enemy in South Korea on January 26, 1951. Corporal Kesler was awarded the Purple Heart, the Combat Infantryman's Badge, the Korean Service Medal, the United Nations Service Medal, the National Defense Service Medal, the Korean Presidential Unit Citation and the Republic of Korea War Service Medal.
