WILLIAM BAUER DIES IN SICILY

Son of Auburndale Couple
Died in Battle, Army
Reports

Auburndale — Pfc. William J. Bauer, Auburndale, has been killed in action in Sicily, according to word received from the War Department yesterday by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. William Bauer Sr.

Pvt. Bauer was inducted on August 25, 1942, and was sent from Camp Grant to Camp Wolters, Texas, receiving his basic training there and at Camp Barkeley, Texas.

He spent eight months at Fort Devens, Mass., and received additional training at Pine Camp, N. Y., and at Camp Pickett, Va., before embarking for Europe at Hampton Roads. He served for one month in Africa before being transferred to Sicily last August.

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
